

## Round Robin ~ Border 3

6 ½" x 24 ½" (6" x 24" finished)

What you need:

- Light background fabric
- Sticky tape
- Washout pencil or marker
- Fusible webbing
- Scraps of fabric for appliqué
- Green embroidery thread

1. Cut two 6 ½" x 24 ½" strips of light background fabric.
2. Print out the appliqué shapes and the vine to trace onto your strips. Tape vine A and B together (they overlap at the small "v" at the top of the bottom vine). Do the same with vine C and D which are mirror images of the others.
3. Using a lightbox or window, trace the vine designs onto your strips of background fabric with a washout pencil or marker. You should have a right vine and a left one ☺ Remember to leave space for the pot, hearts and leaves.
4. Use your preferred method of appliqué to cut out the appliqué shapes. I use the raw edge method and trace my shapes onto the fusible webbing, before ironing it onto my scraps of fabric.
5. Position your appliqué shapes and use your preferred method to appliqué them onto the border strips.
6. Using two strands of green embroidery thread, backstitch the vines.
7. Sew the strips onto the right and left sides of the quilt.

Yay! You've done another border!!
